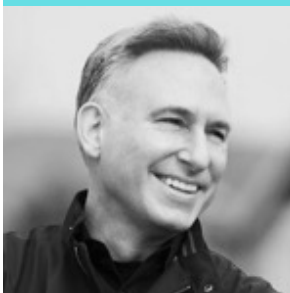

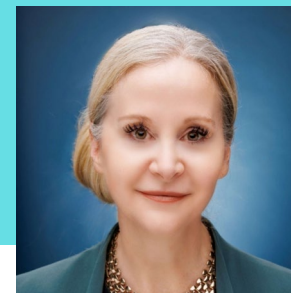

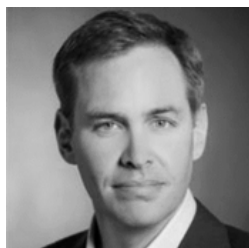

Enable a digital King County that offers equitable access, opportunities, and outcomes for all community members.	
	Lead the standardization of accessibility and language across all communication channels with the community.
	Facilitate the use of tools and measures that remove potential bias from Information Technology initiatives.
	In partnership with broadband and digital equity stakeholders in King County and the Washington State Broadband Office, support efforts to build a Washington State broadband and digital equity plan that addresses unserved/underserved populations.
	Be data-driven when making decisions regarding equitable access and standards across the county.
Continuously Improve Digital Security and Privacy	
	Centralize and streamline Identity Management at King County.
	Ensure the Privacy and Security of our Information Assets.
	Automate King County's Threat Detection Capability.
	Increase the speed of Information Security and Privacy strategy adoption and deployment in the County.



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Goals	Objectives
Enable a connected King County through responsible and managed investment in digital capabilities that deliver a consistent online services experience to the external community.	
	Design and implement a portal experience for the community that serves as a 'one-stop shop' for needed services and information.
	Develop a formal AI Strategy and Roadmap for King County.
Expand the availability, use, and power of data and analytics to advance a data-driven King County.	
	Implement an Enterprise Data Governance Strategy and Roadmap
	Increase the transparency, availability, and use of data relevant to specific areas of focus TBD across the County (equity, quality of services, etc.).
Drive Information Technology Effectiveness and Operational Excellence.	
	Accelerate Legacy Modernization
	Finalize and Implement the Enterprise Architecture
	Deliver a Strategic Information Technology Services Portfolio that Focuses on Enterprise Value
	Create an Information Technology Asset Management Practice to Reduce Risk, Manage Cost, and Improve Service
	Evolve the project oversight and management functions to reduce administrative burden, improve project outcomes, and increase the percentage of on-time project completion.
