

Drainage Facility Liability Insurance Requirement

King County Code (KCC) 09.04.100 Stormwater Runoff and Surface Water and Erosion Control, requires permit applicants to post and maintain liability insurance that names King County as an Additional Insured to protect King County from liability. This amount must not be less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence providing coverage for any liability relating to the construction or maintenance of drainage facilities required by KCC 09.04.050, including coverage for products/completed operations. The King County Risk Manager has the right to establish higher liability insurance coverage requirements. The following outlines the necessary documentation:

- 1. A Certificate of Insurance and a copy of the Additional Insured Endorsement(s) naming King County as Additional Insured.
- 2. Under the Certificate of Insurance section labeled "DESCRIPTION OF OPERATION, LOCATIONS, VEHICLES, SPECIAL ITEMS', please insert:

King County, its appointed and elected officials, officers, and employees, are named as an additional insured with respect to liability relating to the construction or maintenance of the drainage facilities required by permit number ______. This policy provides insurance in the amounts and types of coverage required in KCC 09.04.100.

3. Notice of Cancellation:

Should any of the above-described policies be canceled before the expiration date thereof, the issuing company will mail 30 days written notice to the certificate holder.
