# King County DLS, Permitting Office in Snoqualmie will be temporarily closed to the public to combat the spread of COVID-19

Per guidelines issued by the Governor, the Department of Local Services, Permitting Division will begin accepting requests for construction and land use inspections on Monday, April 27, 2020. In order to qualify for an inspection, the job site must be in compliance with the Governor's <u>Phase 1</u> <u>Construction Restart COVID-19 Job Site Requirements</u>. Job sites that are deemed to not be in compliance with the Governor's guidelines will not be inspected.

  - 1. Review submittal requirements, application forms and supporting document requirements on the <u>Permit application forms by packet</u> web page.
  - 2. Prepare application materials for electronic submittal. Convert all documents and plan sets to a PDF format as outlined in the <u>Electronic Plan Requirements</u> handout.
  - Email your completed <u>Permit Application Form</u> to <u>PermitCenter.DPER@kingcounty.gov</u>. Include your supporting application materials in your email, or for large files please let us know if you wish to transmit your submittal files via a cloud sharing service (DropBox, Google Docs, OneDrive, Adobe Cloud, etc.).
