



# Fireworks Display Permit Information

## Requirements and Deadline:

Per International Fire Code 2021 edition, Chapter 56 and King County Code Title 17, a permit is required for the discharge of fireworks. Please review the information listed below for the permit requirements. A complete Fireworks Display Permit Application packet must be submitted to the County at least **20-days** prior to the date of the display.

**Public fireworks display:** A King County Fireworks Display Permit is required to discharge fireworks that are larger than consumer fireworks and designed primarily to produce visible or audible displays for the public. A Fireworks Display Permit is required from both the State and County Fire Marshal.

**Private fireworks display:** A King County Fireworks Display Permit is required to discharge consumer fireworks for private or religious events. There is no fee associated with such permit.
