

Fuel Tank Removal and Decommissioning Contractors, Application Information

The Department of Local Services, Permitting Division is responsible for review and approval of contractors that remove or decommission fuel tanks in unincorporated King County. Fuel tank contactors must be state licensed and employ ICC UST Certified staff to remove or decommission fuel tanks.

Application Instructions

- Register or sign in to your MyBuildingPermit.com (MBP) account.
- 2. Select the permit type to start your application.

- 3. In the Project Location screen, do not use the address search. In the Location Description field, type "King County" and click Submit.
- 4. Click Continue until you get to the Work Description page. Type "Contractor" in each box. Click Continue.
- 5. On the File Upload page, you will be required to upload a pdf copy of your ICC UST Certification for fuel tank decommissioning. Click continue and complete your application submittal.
- 6. Your application will be screened, and a confirmation email will be sent to you with online payment instructions.

Fuel Tank Decommission Permits

As a licensed contractor with King County your company must:

- 1. Submit tank decommission certifications by applying for a <u>fuel tank decommissioning permit</u> online within 30 days <u>after</u> tank decommission is complete.
- 2. Comply with all provisions of Chapter 34 and Section 5704 of the International Code Council and requirements for decommissioning, abandonment, or removal of underground residential heating oil tanks.
