Forest Practice Moratorium Relief: Requirements Checklist

- 1. Forest Practice Moratorium Relief Application – One original and two copies
- 2. Legal Description – one copy
- 3. Assessor's Maps – one copy
- 4. Site Plans – six copies
These plans shall include the following:
 - Map scale and north arrow
 - Vicinity map – show sufficient area and detail to clearly locate the project in relation to surrounding roads, parks, rivers, and municipal boundaries, together with its scale
 - Property boundaries dimensioned and clearly and accurately delineated by a heavy line of color
 - Location, name, and dimension all existing and proposed streets, and other public ways, easements, utility and railroad rights-of-way within and adjacent to the proposed development
 - Location of major physical features such as railroads, lakes and rivers, including those within 500 feet of the subject property
 - Location of all critical areas and associated buffers. Critical areas include: landslide, steep slope, erosion seismic, coal mine and flood hazards, wetland, aquatic, critical aquifer recharge, and wildlife conservation areas. See KCC 21A.24 for Critical Area Standards and Development Limitations.
 - Accurate dimensions, location, and use of all existing and proposed structures on the subject property indicating porches, eaves, fences and signs. Identify any structures to remain or to be removed; identify existing wells and/or septic tank and drainfields.
 - Easements, deed restrictions, or other encumbrances restricting the use of the property
 - Actual location and extent of tree removal/timber harvest
- 5. Reduced Site Plan – one copy

- 6. Environmental Checklist (only if required by KCC 20.44) – 15 copies
- 7. Affidavit for Application – one copy
- 8. Certification of Applicant (or Certification & Transfer of Applicant) Status Form – one copy
- 9. List of other issued or pending permits or historical decisions related to the proposal – WDNR FPA and Moratorium Notice-On-Title
- 10. Fees per KCC Title 27
- 11. Other documents – list
