

## **Property Research Worksheet**

The King County Department of Local Services, Permitting Division provides land use actions, building and fire permits, and code enforcement for the <u>unincorporated</u> areas of the county.

## **Property Location**

King County provides a number of easy to use, on-line property research services for both incorporated and unincorporated areas of the County.

The most reliable and accurate means of locating property information is to use the parcel number. If the parcel number is unknown, it usually can be located using one of the parcel locator tools.
