- (a) Of the total fee due for a pre-application conference, \$290.40 is due at the time that a request is submitted to the County. This amount is non-refundable (per KCC 27.02.060.A), but will be credited toward the total fee due for the pre-application conference when the request is processed and accepted by the County (per KCC 27.06.010.C).
- (b) The total fee may be credited against related application or permit fees if the related permit application is submitted within 180 days following the pre-application conference, or 60 days of other agency approvals required for a complete application.
- (c) Excluding critical aquifer recharge area or erosion hazard area.
- (d) Fees are due upon application.
