- (a) Appeal fees established by KCC 4A.780.010. Appeals by an applicant require a deposit commensurate with the expected cost of processing the appeal, in addition to a non-refundable appeal filing fee of \$250, per KCC 20.24.450. If the appeal by the applicant is granted, the deposit will be refunded to the applicant. If the appeal is denied, the applicant will be charged for the County's actual cost of responding to the appeal, excluding the costs of the conducting the public hearing itself.
- (b) Appeal right defined in KCC 13.24.090; appeal fee established by KCC 4A.710.100
- (c) Fees totaling less than \$2.00 per customer per day shall be waived.

Charging for Copying, per the Public Records Act [RCW 42.56.070(8) and 120]:

- No fee shall be charged for the inspection of public records.
- No fee shall be charged for locating public documents and making them available for copying.
- Agency charges for photocopies shall be imposed in accordance with the actual per page cost or other costs established and published by the agency. In no event may an agency charge a per page cost greater than the actual per page cost as established and published by the agency.
- An agency may require a deposit in an amount not to exceed ten percent of the estimated cost of providing copies for a request.
- If an agency makes a request available on a partial or installment basis, the agency may charge for each part of the request as it is provided. If an installment of a records request is not claimed or reviewed, the agency is not obligated to fulfill the balance of the request.
