

## Summary of Proposed Ordinance relating to Interlocal Agreement with Mountain View Fire & Rescue and South King Fire

This summary fulfills Washington State Growth Management Act and King County Code (K.C.C.) 20.18.100 requirements for a “plain language summary.”

King County is proposing to execute interlocal agreements ("ILAs") with the Mountain View Fire & Rescue and South King Fire to allow these agencies to provide fire inspection services within unincorporated King County. The interlocal agreements provide the opportunity for the local agencies, who have familiarity with the communities they serve, and who provide fire protection services to the same communities, to take the lead on administering inspection services.

The interlocal agreement enables the departments to conduct fire inspections on behalf of the County.	The County can contract with other agencies to provide services, but state law (RCW 39.34.080) requires that the County Council to authorize the County to do so. This ordinance authorizes the Executive to execute the agreement.
