2 AN ORDINANCE authorizing the King County executive
3 to execute identical interlocal agreements with Mountain
4 View Fire & Rescue and South King Fire delegating
5 administrative duties to perform inspections of the fire code
6 operational permit program of regulated occupancies in fire
7 protection districts 39 and 44.

9 STATEMENT OF FACTS:

- 10 1. The county adopted K.C.C. Title 17, also known as the Fire Code of
11 King County, to set fire safety standards within its unincorporated
12 areas.
- 13 2. K.C.C. 17.04.230.3 authorizes the county fire marshal to delegate fire
14 prevention inspection authority to the chiefs of the King County fire
15 districts and city fire departments within the county through interlocal
16 agreements.
- 17 3. The County, Mountain View Fire & Rescue, and South King Fire
18 agree that Mountain View Fire & Rescue and South King Fire are in
19 the best position to administer and perform inspections of the fire code
20 operational permit program on behalf of the county.

- 21 4. Interlocal agreements between the county and Mountain View Fire &
22 Rescue and between the county and South King Fire to administer the
23 fire code operational permit program on behalf of the County is
24 authorized by chapter 19.27 RCW, the State Building Code Act, and
25 chapter 39.34 RCW, the Interlocal Cooperation Act.
- 26 5. King County maintains all local governmental authority and
27 jurisdiction to adopt, interpret and amend the International Fire Code
28 (“IFC”), within unincorporated King County.

29 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

30 The county executive is hereby authorized to execute contract agreements with
31 Mountain View Fire & Rescue and South King Fire relating to the administration of the
32 fire code operational permit program in unincorporated King County in substantially the
33 form of Attachments A and B to this ordinance.
