Project Description: The proposed project involves the installation of a new mooring buoy consisting of an 18" Taylor Made surface mooring buoy, secured with a chain to a shackle, with a corresponding mid-line float (7" diameter by 15" long) and swivel system near the anchor. It will be anchored with a helical screw anchor into the substrate.	
Permit requested in this application: Shoreline Exemption

The Department of Local Services, Permitting Division will issue an Environmental Threshold Determination pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) on this application following a **21-day public comment period** which ends on **April 1st, 2024**. The responsible official has a reasonable basis for expecting to issue a SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) on this project. As such, the optional DNS/MDNS notice process is being used pursuant to WAC 197-11-355. The project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared.

This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. Written comments on this application must be submitted to Permitting Division at the address above by the end of the comment period.
