Project Description: Stabilize the bulkhead by filling voids in the soil on the landward side of the timber bulkhead with SW-RP1 poly resin. Drilling 4" holes in bulkhead and installing a jet filter system to drain groundwater and over-topping marine water into Puget Sound.

Permit requested in this application: Shoreline Exemptions

Consistency with applicable County plans and regulations: This proposal will be reviewed for compliance with all applicable King County codes including Roads Standards, Surface Water Design Manual, Zoning, Grading and Critical Areas Codes.

King County Code requires notification of property owners within at least 500 feet of the project proposed above, so they can obtain additional information about the proposal and comment if they wish (KCC 20.20).

The Department of Local Services, Permitting Division will issue an Environmental Threshold Determination pursuant to the State Environmental Policy Act (SEPA) on this application following a **30-day public comment period** which ends on **August 17, 2025.** The responsible official has a reasonable basis for expecting to issue a SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) on this project. As such, the optional DNS/MDNS notice process is being used pursuant to WAC 197-11-355. The project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared.

This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. Written comments on this application must be submitted to Permitting Division at the address above by the end of the comment period.
