20-20-701 <u>Purpose</u>. It is the purpose of these rules to implement the provisions of K.C.C. 20.20.060 by prescribing the form and design requirements for posted public notice.

**20-20-702** Form and Design Requirements. A. The layout of posted public notice shall be on a notice board generally as follows:



- B. The lettering for posted public notice shall be as follows:
- 1. the lettering style shall be Helvetica or similar standard type face;
- 2. the lettering size shall be no less than 1 inch letters for the title "NOTICE OF PROPOSED LAND USE ACTION" and no less than 1 inch capital letters for all other letters except 8.5 by 14 inch laminated paper;
- 3. the lettering color shall be black permanent ink or overlay against a white background; and
- 4. individual placards for SEPA notice and public notice shall be on 8.5 by 14 inch laminated paper.
- C. The notice board may be modified to allow posting of several actions to be posted simultaneously, provided the content as outlined in section A of this rule is not altered and lettering required in section B of this rule is maintained.
- **20-20-703** <u>Severability</u>. If a provision of the rules contained herein or its applicability to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the provisions of these rules or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances shall not be affected.
