

## KING COUNTY GROWTH MANAGEMENT PLANNING COUNCIL

**AGENDA TITLE:** King County Countywide Growth Management Act Calendar

**PRESENTED BY:** Interjurisdictional Team (IJT)

### **Topics for Discussion:**

The next required update to Comprehensive Plans for jurisdictions in King County is due by June 20, 2023. Between now and then, a number of planning processes will occur. These include the following:

- VISION 2040 is being extended to 2050. Updates to VISION include changes to multicounty planning policies and the regional growth strategy.
- Based on the changes in VISION 2050, and other factors, updates will be needed to the countywide planning policies and jurisdictional growth targets.
- Before growth targets are completed, King County and the jurisdictions in the county are required to update the countywide Urban Growth Capacity study, also known as the Buildable Lands Report.
- After Comprehensive Plan updates are underway, the State Office of Financial Management will release its official growth projections. Jurisdictions must ensure that their planning policies and regulations are consistent with these projections.

For the past six months, the IJT has worked to develop a Countywide Growth Management Act calendar that aligns these processes and schedules. At the November 28, 2018 meeting, the proposed schedule will be presented. Because the dates on the schedule are not binding and may be adjusted over the coming years, the countywide schedule is *not* proposed for adoption by the Growth Management Planning Council.
