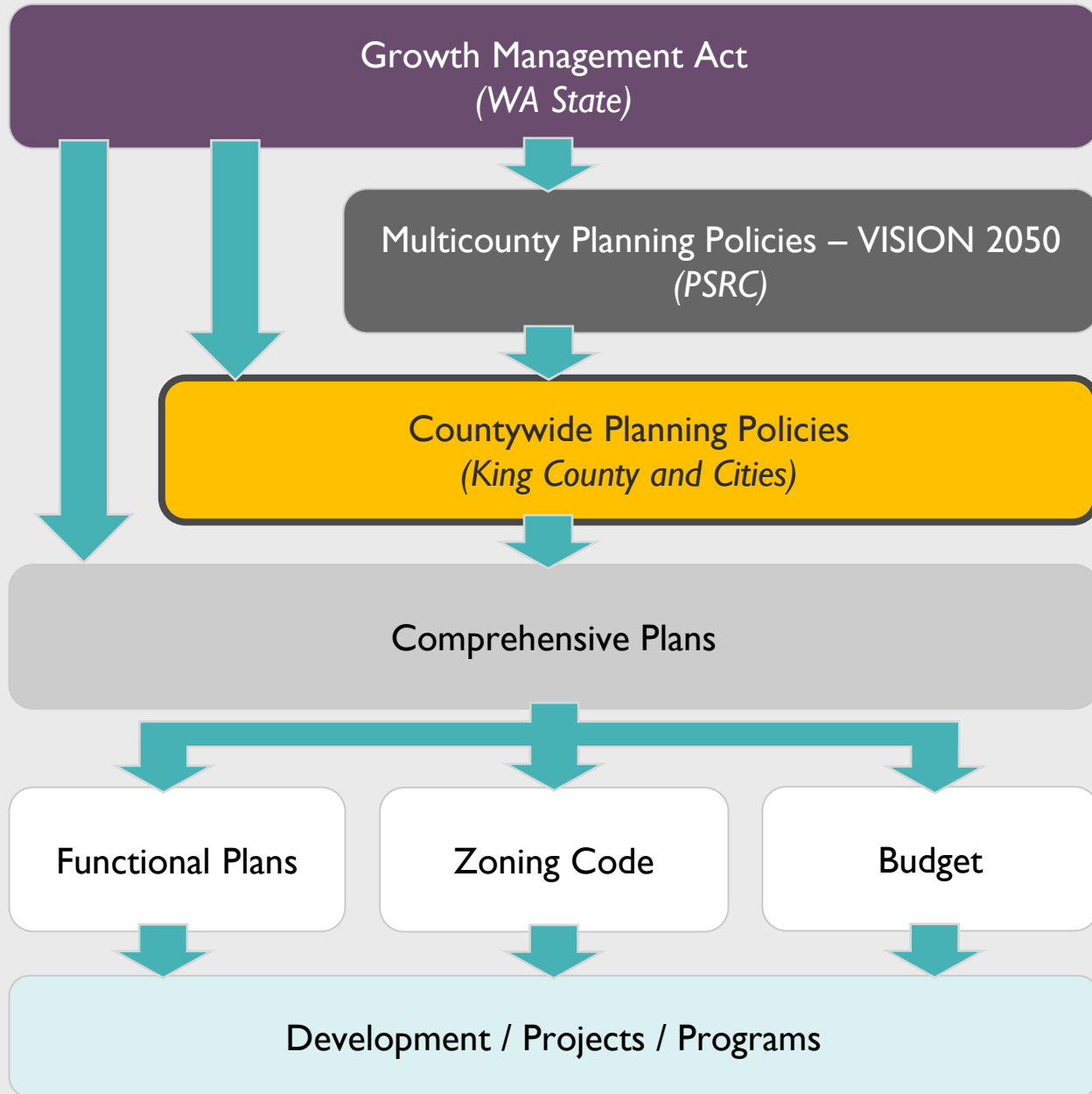

WHAT ARE THE CPPs?

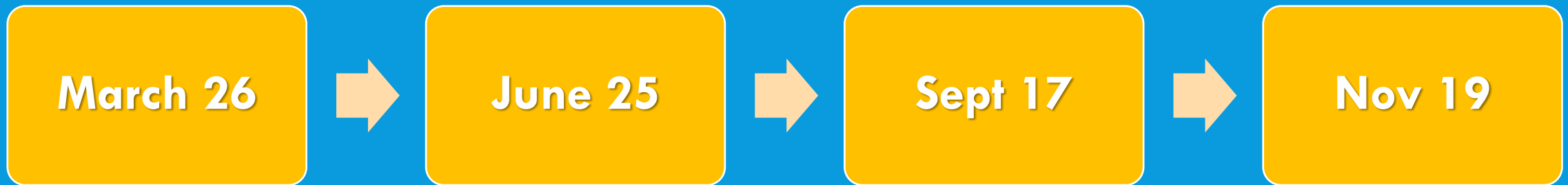
- Shared framework for planning for all jurisdictions in King County.
- Implement the State GMA and VISION 2050 Multicounty Planning Policies.
- Comprehensive plans are developed within the CPP framework.
- There have been King County CPPs since the mid-1990s and the last major update was in 2021.
 - *Updated to align with:* PSRC's VISION 2050 & Regional Centers Framework; GMA changes (1110, 1220, etc.); Affordable Housing Committee Action Plan
 - *Amendments since 2021:* Housing CPPs & Accountability Framework; Four-to-One and UGA policies; Sammamish, Carnation & Snoqualmie Growth Targets; UGA changes; Countywide Center Planning

WHAT IS THE GMPC?

- Growth Management Act established a requirement for Countywide Planning Policies
- GMPC formed by Interlocal Agreement in 1992
 - Voting members are King County, Seattle, Bellevue, Sound Cities
 - Schools and Special Purpose Districts have non-voting seats
 - Supported by an Interjurisdictional Staff Team
- In 2019, formed an Affordable Housing Committee
 - Committee has its own Housing Interjurisdictional Staff Team

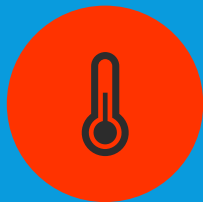
