Project Description: A Conditional Use Permit (CUP) to allow construction of a recreational campsite consist of 8 tent, 25 RV and 15 cabin sites together with all supporting facilities, such as parking, toilet/shower, kitchen, office/host and an onsite store for campers. The project will be constructed in three phases.

Consistency with applicable County plans and regulations: This proposal will be reviewed for compliance with all applicable King County codes including Roads Standards, Surface Water Design Manual, Zoning, Grading and Critical Areas Codes.

You are receiving this notice because King County property records indicate that you own property within 500 feet of the proposed project described above.

The Department of Local Services, Permitting Division (DLS-Permitting) will issue a written decision on this application following a **21-day public comment** period which ends **August 7**, **2023**. Written comments on this application must be submitted to DLS-Permitting at the address above. A public hearing is not required for this application prior to the DLS-Permitting decision. However, the decision may be appealed to the King County Hearing Examiner, who would conduct an appeal hearing prior to making a decision on the appeal. Details of the appeal process will be included in the notice of decision.

This may be the only opportunity to comment on the environmental impacts of the proposal. The responsible official has a reasonable basis for expecting to issue a SEPA Determination of Non-Significance (DNS) on this project. As such, the optional DNS notice process is being used pursuant to WAC 197-11-355. The project review process may incorporate or require mitigation measures regardless of whether an EIS is prepared.
