SW 104th St between 15th Ave SW and 17th Ave SW

Project Overview

In March/April 2025, we will replace a worn-out drainage pipe located under the north side of SW 104th St (between 15th Ave SW and 17th Ave SW). The work is expected to last up to six (6) weeks, including a two-week-long road closure across the intersection of 16th Ave SW at SW 104th St.

Why we are doing this project

We're preparing the intersection for the Pedestrian Safety Improvements & Traffic Calming Project this summer. Underground drainage work is happening first, and crews will return in July/August to repave the road and add curb extensions to make crossing safer.

What to expect during construction:

- Work will occur in three phases.
- Work hours: 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays (M-F) Weekend work is possible.
- No Parking on SW 104th St.
- North half of intersection closed at 16th Ave SW and SW 104th St. for up to two (2) weeks.
- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained throughout construction.



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
