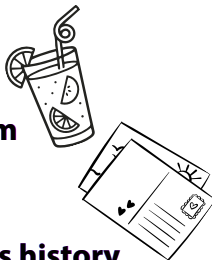

This temporary bridge will keep the community connected while the brand-new permanent bridge is anticipated to be built from 2029 to 2031. The timber bridge is now closed to vehicles and bicycles, and will close to pedestrians on September 30, 2026.
