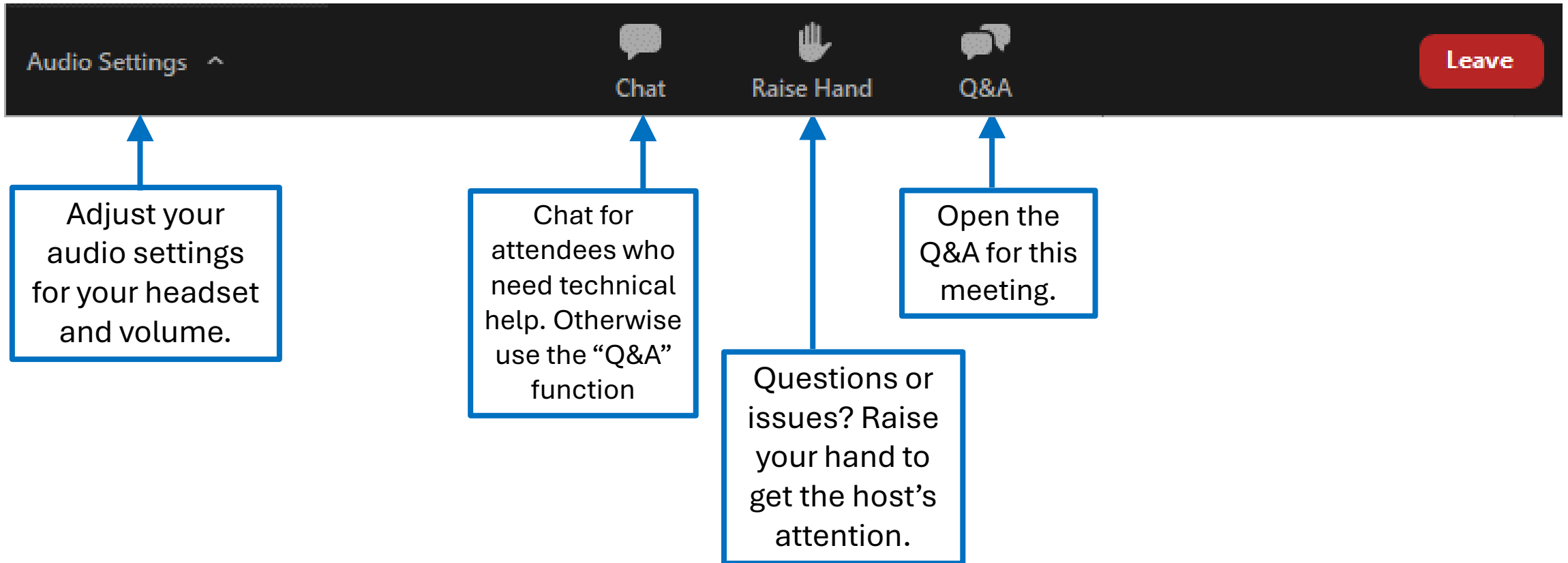

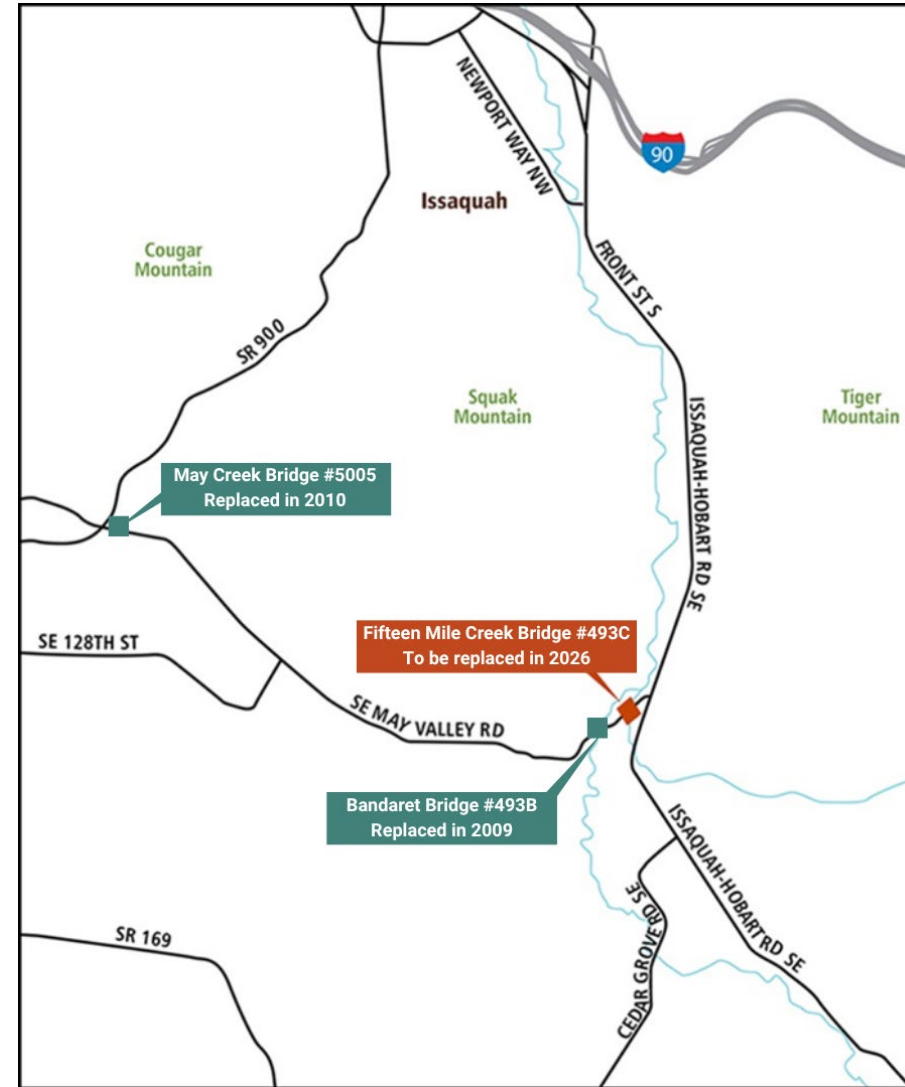

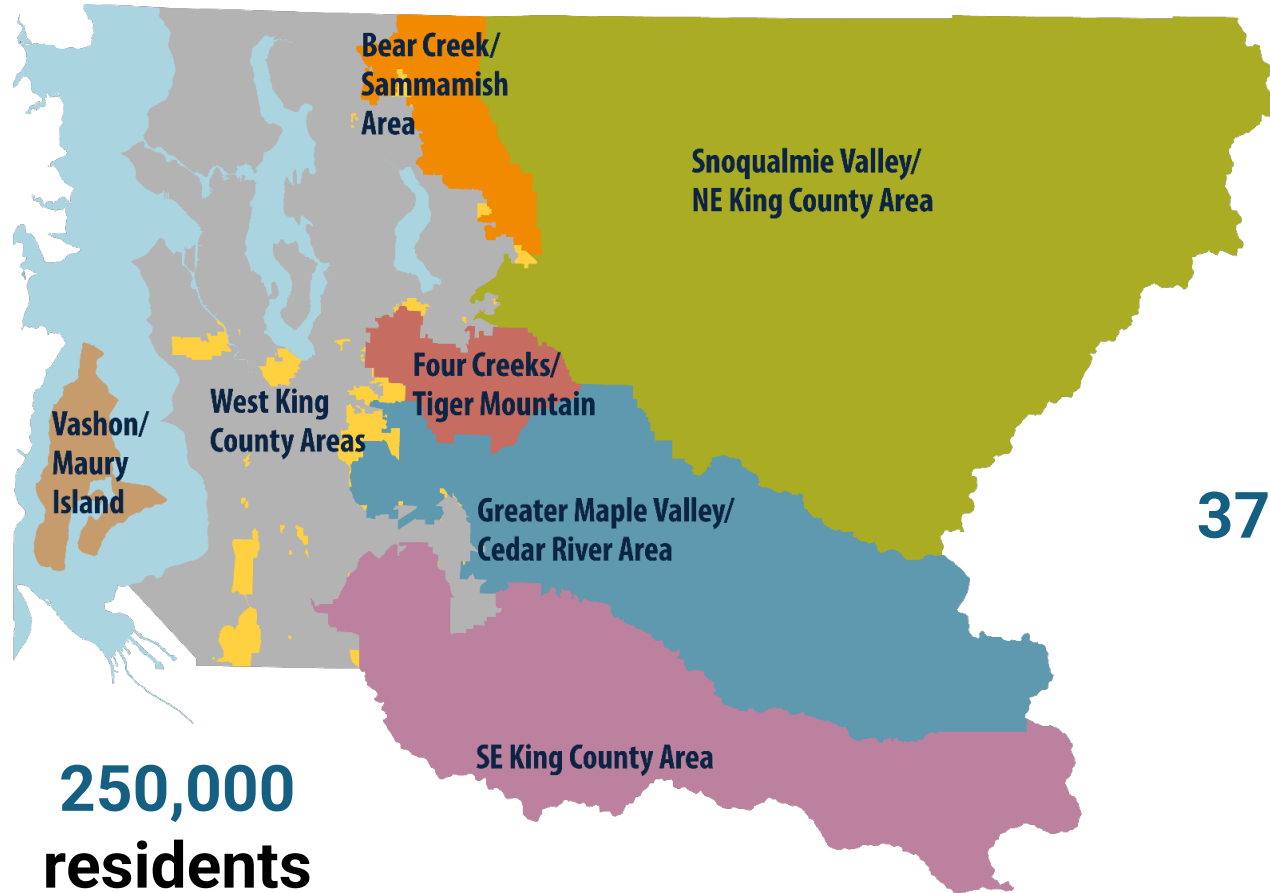

# Project Overview

- Fifteen Mile Creek Bridge is an important route through May Valley.
- Existing bridge is old and in poor condition.
- New Concrete bridge:
  - Built in the same location
  - Wider shoulders
  - No weight restrictions
  - Improved visibility
  - Less maintenance cost
  - Expected to last over 75 years
  - Better for the environment
- Estimated project budget: \$6 million.



# Project Timeline

Anticipated construction –12 weeks

**SE May Valley Road near Issaquah-Hobart Road SE will be closed mid-June through late August.**

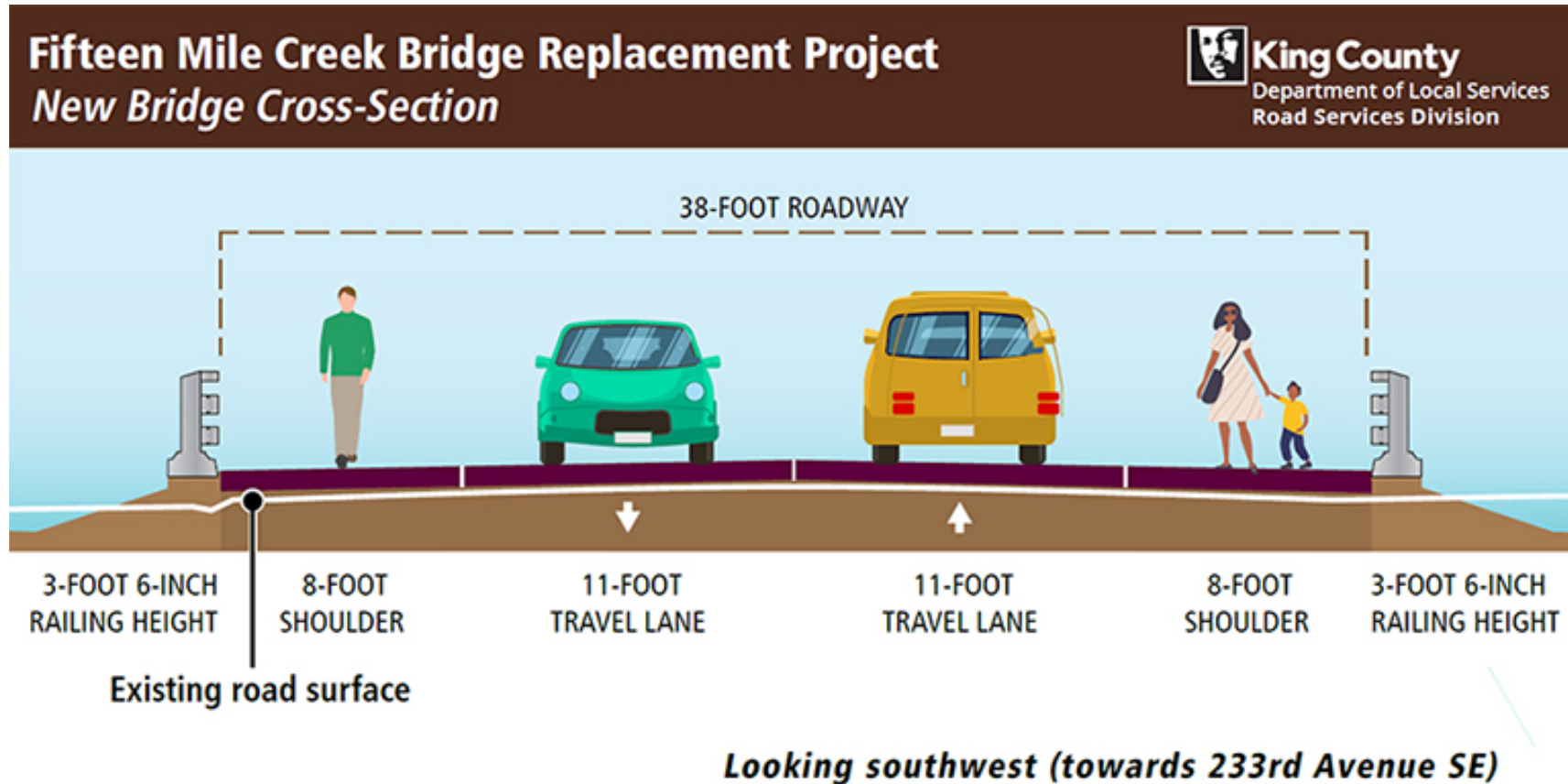
While closed, there will be no through access for vehicles, bicycles, pedestrians, school buses, emergency response (ambulances, fire trucks, police).

# What to Expect During Construction

- Lane restrictions will begin June 2nd as construction mobilizes
- The existing bridge **will be fully closed as soon Monday, June 15th**
- Noise from saw cutting, jackhammers, excavators, a drill rig, trucks, generators, and pumps
- Trucks hauling materials to and from the construction site
- Protection of the creek
- Extended day and weekend work within the construction noise regulations

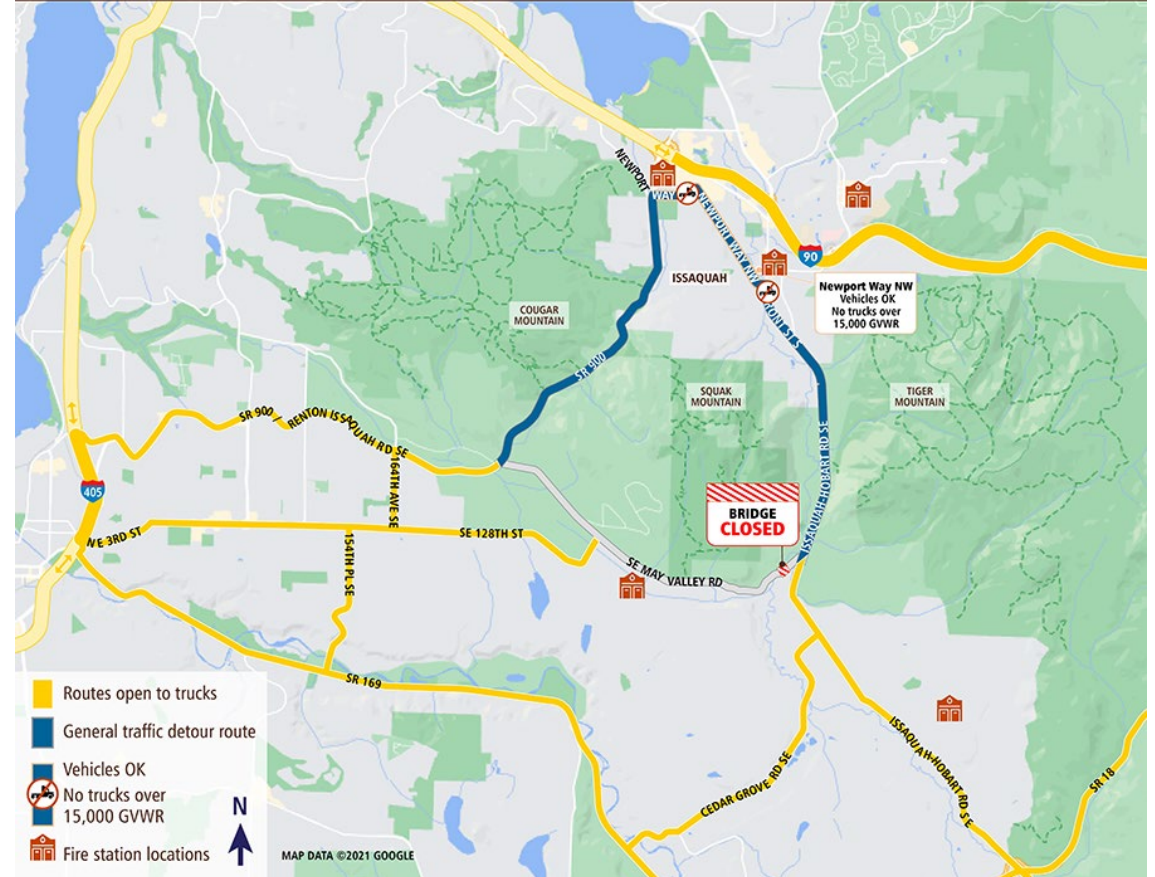
## Fifteen Mile Creek Bridge General Traffic Detour Route

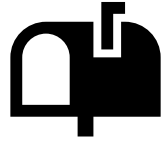


## Fifteen Mile Creek Bridge Alternate Truck Routes

# Frequently Asked Questions



## Mail Service & Delivery

We are working closely with the US Post Office: Issaquah Branch to temporarily relocate any mailboxes that are currently within the project closure area.



## Solid Waste Services

We've coordinated with local garbage and recycling providers to share project details so that service continues without disruption during the closure.



## Emergency Response Times

We have been in close communication with Eastside Fire & Rescue and the Bellevue Fire Department and have been assured that emergency response times will not be affected by the closure.



## Utilities

Utility relocation work is completed in two phases: One before construction and one after. The first phase is underway and is expected to be completed before construction starts.

Utilities are responsible for communicating with their customers about any potential disruptions to service.
