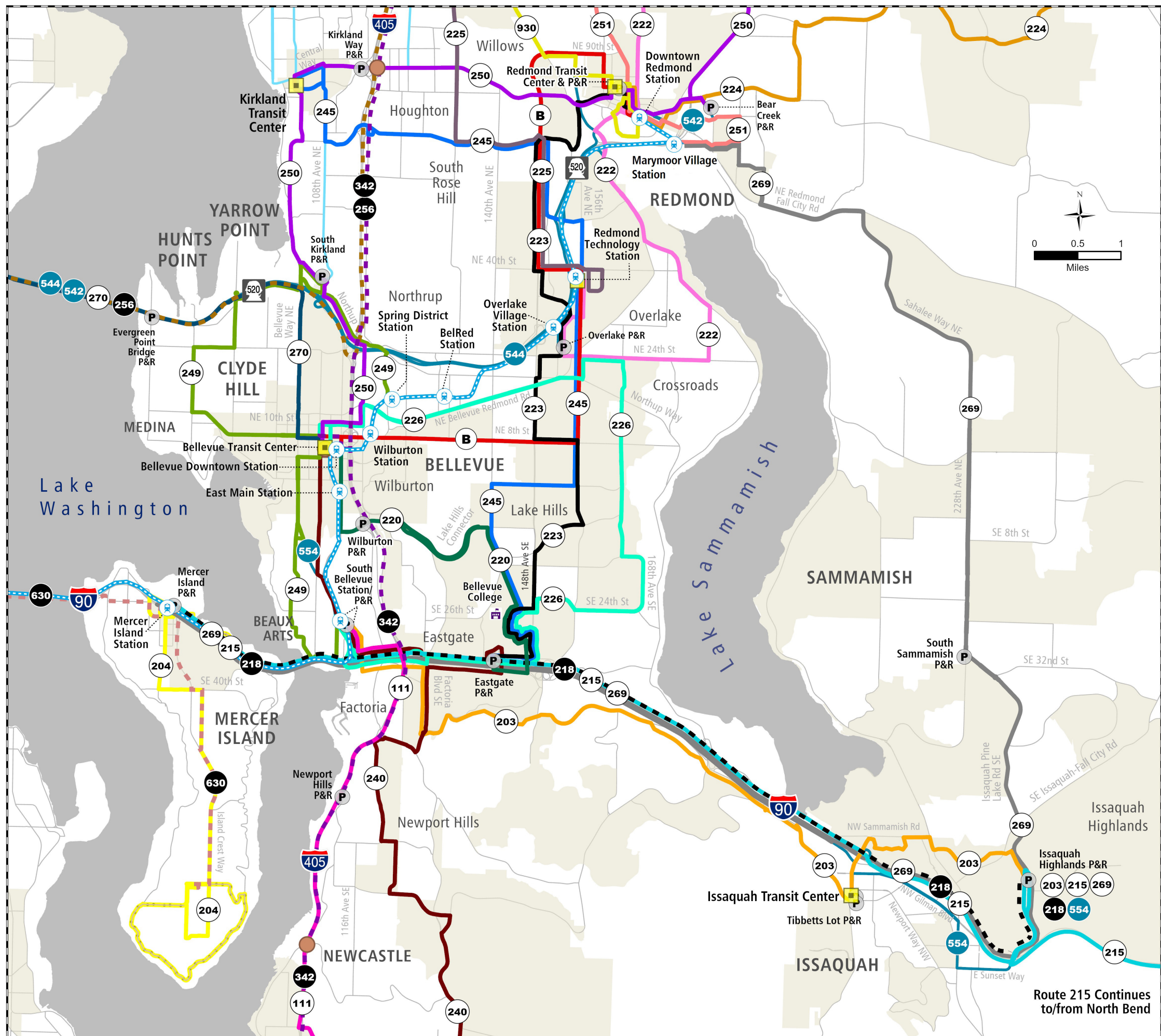


East Link Connections Project: Phase 3 Proposed Network in the East Subarea
