The King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has received and reviewed the investigative materials from the King County Sheriff's Office, concerning the in-custody death of KCJ inmate Colin Cooper at the Harborview Medical Center on April 28, 2017.

Pursuant to Executive Order PHL-7-1-5-EO, we recommend an inquest be initiated because we have not identified any factors or circumstances under §6.1, or any other reasons, that indicate that an inquest is not warranted.
