The King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has received and reviewed the investigative materials from the Valley Independent Investigation Team concerning the in-custody death of Shannon Burrage on August 12, 2023.

After a careful review of these materials, we are satisfied that the investigation is now complete. Pursuant to Executive Order PHL-7-1-5-EO, we recommend an inquest not be initiated because the role of law enforcement was *de minimis* and did not contribute in any discernable way to a person's death.
