Dear Executive Constantine:

The King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has received and reviewed the investigative materials from the Seattle Police Department Force Investigation Team, concerning the officer-involved shooting of Terry Caver on May 19, 2020.

In accordance with Executive Order PHL-7-1-5-EO §7.1, we are satisfied that the investigation is now complete and recommend that an inquest be initiated pursuant to the King County Charter §895, which requires a mandatory inquest unless, under PHL-7-1-5-EO §6.1, you determine that the role of law enforcement was de minimis and did not contribute in any discernable way to a person's death.

Per PHL-7-1-5-EO §8.4, upon your request, we will forward the investigative file to the Inquest Program Manager. Such requests can be sent to PAOPublicIntegrity@kingcounty.gov.
