**Dear Executive Constantine:** 

The King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has received and reviewed the investigative memorandum from the Snohomish County Prosecuting Attorney, concerning the officer-involved shooting of Eucytus on March 20, 2023. After learning preliminary details regarding the officer-involved shooting, the King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office determined it would have a potential conflict of interest in assisting in the investigation and conducting a legal analysis. In response, we requested the Snohomish County Prosecuting Attorney's Office to oversee the investigation and analysis, which they did and their subsequent memorandum is attached.

Pursuant to Executive Order PHL-7-1-5-EO, we recommend an inquest be initiated because we have not identified any factors or circumstances under §6.1, or any other reasons, that indicate that an inquest is not warranted.
