On September 2, 2020, the King County Prosecuting Attorney's Office received the investigative materials from the Auburn Police Department, concerning the shooting death of River T. Hudson by officers of the Renton Police Department on May 6, 2020.

This office has reviewed those materials and is satisfied that the investigation is now complete. Pursuant to Executive Order PHL-7-1-2-EO, we recommend an inquest be initiated because we have not identified any factors or circumstances under §6.2, or any other reasons, that indicate that an inquest is not warranted.
