4	PREAMBLE:		
5	King County implemented a body	worn camera program in 2023. Full	
6	deployment of body worn camera	as is projected by year-end in 2024. King	
7	County's law enforcement officer	s wear body cameras and capture video	
8	and audio recordings of interaction	ons between the King County sheriff's	
9	office's deputies and people in the	e community. Those recordings are	
10	subject to the Washington Public	Records Act, chapter 42.56 RCW. Upon	
11	request for body worn camera rec	ordings, the sheriff's office's Public	
12	Disclosure Unit is required to rev	iew the recordings and, under the RCW,	
13	to redact portions of them. Redac	cting body worn camera recordings is a	
14	time-consuming process. Addition	onal work associated with processing the	
15	recordings has necessitated King	County to add specialists in the sheriff's	
16	office's Public Disclosure Unit.	People involved in an incident recorded	
17	by a body worn camera may requ	est and receive related body worn camera	
18	recordings free of charge, consist	ent with the authority in RCW	
19	42.56.240(14). The Public Recor	ds Act allows a law enforcement agency	
20	to charge requestors a reasonable	cost to redact recordings when the	

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21	requesters are not directly involved in an incident recorded by the
22	requested body worn camera recording. King County does not currently
23	charge for that cost. Charging a fee would allow King County to offset
24	some of the costs associated with redacting body worn camera recordings.
25	BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:
26	SECTION 1. Under RCW 42.56.240(14)(f), law enforcement agencies are
27	permitted to charge requestors not exempted under RCW 42.56.240(14)(e) the reasonable
28	costs of redacting videos before disclosing the videos.
29	NEW SECTION. SECTION 2. There is hereby added to K.C.C. chapter 4A.680
30	a new section to read as follows:
31	The following fee shall be charged by the sheriff's office, public disclosure unit:
32	Time spent reviewing and redacting body

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34 worn camera video:

\$0.92 per minute, or \$55.00 per hour

35 <u>SECTION 3.</u> This ordinance takes effect January 1, 2024.
