- Your family will make the final decisions for your family, not a Judge
- Reduces potential of needing the court's intervention
- Option to keep your legal petition in place, if filed, while court monitors mediated outcomes

New Truancy Program: Community Attendance Support Team (CAST)

The King County Community Attendance Support Team (CAST) is a county-level Community Engagement Board, facilitated by the King County Superior Court Becca Program. The CAST aims to promote school attendance and prevent school drop out by facilitating meetings between students, families, schools, and community agencies to identify barriers to school attendance and recommend solutions. Parents and school districts can make a CAST referral after a student has accumulated unexcused absences from school as a step to try to prevent a truancy petition from being filed. The CAST is available to any student with a truancy petition in King County.
