Through the end of May 2024, property tax revenues combined for all levies are above forecast by \$1.8 million or 0.27 percent. This includes the first half of the property tax collections for 2024. The year to date differences in the actuals versus the March forecast for individual levies is between -1.8 and 5 percent. However, two levies, Conservation futures and Crisis Care Center levies have seen actuals come in below forecast by more than 1% at


-1.3 and -1.8 percent, respectively. The first five months of collections of penalties and interest on delinquent property taxes came in \$1.4 million or 17 percent above forecast.

Total taxable sales, categorized by industry sectors, were down in the first 4 months of 2024 by 1 percent yoy growth. Some industry sectors were up like management of companies up 82.9 percent, utilities up 47.7 percent, educational services up 42.6 percent, transportation and warehousing up 12.6 percent, health care and social assistance up 15.4 percent and arts, entertainment and recreation up 7.2 percent over last year. Some sectors for the first four months of 2024 were down from last year like wholesale trade sales down 1.3 percent (yoy), construction sales down 7.6 percent (yoy), finance and insurance down 8.1 percent and manufacturing sales down 7.5 percent (yoy). The first four months of 2024 saw sales taxes slightly below the forecast by \$7.3 million, 1.9 percent, for four out of the five sales tax levies. Sales tax distributions for transit were down the most at 2 percent of \$5.6 million. Three other sales tax levies, the local option, MIDD and criminal justice were each down about 2 percent or less from the March forecast through April. The sales taxes for Health through Housing were up a small amount by 0.1 percent, for the first four months of 2024. The Cultural Access Program sales tax had its first month of collection, which came in below projections (5.4 percent below).

Other revenue streams that deviated from forecast by more than one percent included the marijuana excise tax being up 20.6 percent cumulatively for the first quarter but this tax was not collected in May as King County receives distributions quarterly for this tax. Real estate excise taxes were currently tracking 11.3 percent above forecast, and lodging tax (HB 2015) was up 26.6 percent over projections in March for the first four months. Other forecasts were below forecast for the first four months by more than one percent: hotel/motel taxes (9.5 percent below), E-911 excise taxes (7.9 percent below), motor vehicle fuel taxes (7.6 percent below) and solid waste charges (3.8 percent below).

The graphs on the following pages indicate revenues from specific funds, including comparisons between monthly revenues as currently forecasted, shown by the blue bars, actual monthly revenues, indicated by the burgundy bars and the red line showing the cumulative difference between forecasts and actuals. The table below the graphs show the single month of April's forecast, actual and difference for each taxing district's levy.


An appendix to this memo provides King County taxable retail sales by industry for April 2023 and April 2024. This table indicates that in the month of April, total taxable sales were down year over year by 2.6 percent. The areas of growth in taxable sales over a year ago included wholesale (up 25.6 percent), public administration & DOL monthly forecasts (up 9.8 percent), other services (up 10.5 percent), management, education and health services (up 7.9 percent), transportation & warehousing (up 7.3 percent), arts, entertainment & recreation (up 1.9 percent), and accommodations and food service (up 1 percent). Some industries taxable sales in April were down over last year like information (down 34.4 percent), construction (down 10.4 percent), and finance & insurance (down 9.9 percent).

Current Expense Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



UAL/Roads Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



Parks Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



AFIS Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



VSHSL Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



Conservation Futures Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



EMS Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



Transit Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



Puget Sound Emergency Radio Network Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



Best Starts for Kids Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)



Crisis Care Centers Property Taxes Comparison (May 2024)








MIDD Sales Tax Comparison (April 2024)

Transit Sales Tax Comparison (April 2024)







Marijuana Excise Tax Comparison (May 2024)



MV Fuel Taxes Comparison (May 2024)




E-911 Excise Tax Comparison (April 2024)

Hotel/Motel Tax Comparison (April 2024)





Real Estate Excise Tax (REET 1) Comparison (May 2024)



Wastewater Revenues Comparison (May 2024)


