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2024 Actuals Compared to Budget Forecasts

Through the end of July 2024, property tax revenues combined for all levies are above forecast by \$0.6 million or 0.1 percent. This includes the first half of the property tax collections for 2024. The year-to-date (yoy) differences in the actuals versus the March forecast for individual levies is between -2 and 5 percent. The EMS levy has come in the strongest at \$3 million, 5 percent, above the March forecast. However, two levies, Conservation futures and Crisis Care Center levies have seen actuals come in below forecast by more than 1% at -1.4 and -2 percent, respectively. The first seven months of collections of penalties and interest on delinquent property taxes came in \$2.6 million or 21 percent above forecast.

Total taxable sales, categorized by industry sectors, were down in the first seven months of 2024 by 1 percent yoy. Year-to-date, some industry sectors were up: management of companies up 56.7 percent, utilities up 14 percent, educational services up 36 percent, transportation and warehousing up 16.7 percent, health care and social assistance up 24 percent and arts, entertainment, and recreation up 4.3 percent over last year. Some sectors for the first seven months of 2024 were down from last year like retail trade sales down 1.1 percent (yoy), construction sales down 8.5 percent (yoy), information sales down 7.3 percent (yoy), finance and insurance down 5.2 percent, real estate, rental and leasing down 2.0 percent (yoy), and manufacturing sales down 3.8 percent (yoy). An appendix to this memo provides King County taxable retail sales by industry for the most recent month July 2024 compared to July 2023. This table indicates that in the month of July, total taxable sales were up slightly yoy by 0.7 percent. The July aggregate taxable sales report shows more positive yoy growth than prior months in 2024 but that is due to unusually large payments in the information and transportation & warehousing sectors. The areas of growth in taxable sales over a year ago included management, education, and health services (up 5.5 percent), transportation & warehousing (up 41.3 percent), wholesale (up 6.2 percent), accommodations and food service (up 11.7 percent), information services (up 21.6 percent), other services (up 9.9 percent), public administration / DOL monthly (up 3.9 percent) and real estate, rental, and leasing (up 1.1 percent). Unfortunately, some industries taxable sales in July were down over last year like utilities (down 30.2 percent), construction (down 8.2 percent), manufacturing (down 1.8 percent), professional, scientific, and technical services (down 3.3 percent), retail (down 1.0 percent), and arts, entertainment, and recreation (down 1.9 percent).

The first seven months of 2024 saw sales taxes below the March forecast by \$19.9 million, 2.7 percent, for all six sales tax levies. Sales tax distributions for transit were down the most \$14.1 million from the March forecast. Most of the sales tax levies were down from the March forecast by at least 2.6 percent except for the Health through Housing levy. The Cultural Access Program sales tax had the highest percentage decline of 3.1 percent. The Health through Housing sales tax was down the smallest percentage by 0.4 percent from the March forecast through July.

Other revenue streams that deviated from forecast by more than one percent included the marijuana excise tax being up 10.9 percent cumulatively for the first seven months. Real estate excise taxes were currently tracking 9.9 percent above forecast through August, and lodging tax (HB 2015) was up 24 percent over projections in March through July. Other forecasts were below forecast for the first seven months by more than one percent: hotel/motel taxes (4.8 percent below), E-911 excise taxes (6.4 percent below), motor vehicle fuel taxes (9.1 percent below) and solid waste charges (3.9 percent below).

2024 Actuals Compared to OEFA August Forecasts

On August 28, 2024, the King County Forecast Council adopted a new August 2024 revenue forecast. This forecast modified the March 2024 forecast used for setting the 2024 budget. One important element of revision in the August 2024 revenue forecast was the forecast for King County taxable sales as it was reduced by 4.9 percent from the March forecast. This resulted in a lower forecast for sales tax levies. For most 2024 property tax levies, the new August forecast was a minor revision downward from March due to slightly lower new construction, but some levies were positively impacted by higher assessed value projections. Penalties and interest on delinquent property taxes had been raised since the March forecast and now actuals are cumulatively tracking the latest forecast within 3 percent.

Below is a table comparing the monthly 2024 OEFA August forecasts to the monthly actuals received so far in 2024 for those OEFA forecasts that were impacted by the August revisions from the March forecast.


Since the August forecast for taxable sales was revised downward by nearly 5% in 2024 from the March forecast, the difference in actual sales tax levies cumulatively for the first seven months is up \$16.9 million, 2.4 percent, from the August forecast.

Since the August forecast, the marijuana, lodging tax and REET 1 forecasts were each revised upward from the March forecast. Now for the first seven and eight months of 2024 actuals compared to the latest forecast is up for the marijuana excise tax by \$112,922, 7.8 percent and the lodging tax was also up now by \$429,716 or 13.5 percent. The hotel/motel tax was also now above the new latest forecast by \$1.9 million, 8.8 percent. The E-911 excise tax actuals are also tracking the August forecast by \$15,383, 0.1 percent. The REET 1 actuals compared to the new August forecast is the only forecast slightly down by -1.2 percent.



Current Expense Taxes Comparison (August 2024)



UAL/Roads Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)



Parks Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)





VSHSL Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)



Conservation Futures Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)



EMS Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)



Transit Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)



Puget Sound Emergency Radio Network Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)



Best Starts for Kids Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)



Crisis Care Centers Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)



Penalties and Interest on Delinquent Property Taxes Comparison (August 2024)




Local Option Sales Tax Comparison (July 2024)




MIDD Sales Tax Comparison (July 2024)

Transit Sales Tax Comparison (July 2024)





MV Fuel Taxes Comparison (August 2024)




E-911 Excise Tax Comparison (July 2024)

Hotel/Motel Tax Comparison (July 2024)





Real Estate Excise Tax (REET 1) Comparison (August 2024)




