At yesterday's prehearing conference, the complainant and appellant agreed to try to negotiate a solution. The complainant emailed that they had been able to successfully hash out a plan, with appellant agreeing not to leave the dog outside between 8 PM and 8 AM. We commend the parties on their speedy resolution.

Therefore, we DISMISS WITHOUT PREJUDICE the violation notice and the appeal. A dismissal without prejudice does not preclude Animal Services from later reissuing a violation notice for the same underlying events, if things later go south. However, we are confident that that will not happen here.

If for some reason we have misunderstood the situation, by **September 18, 2020**, either party is free to file, with the examiner, a motion for reconsideration explaining why the examiner should not be dismissing this appeal. Filing a timely motion for reconsideration postpones the deadline (described below the signature line) for lodging an appeal.
