Regional Animal Services of King County is dismissing this Notice of Violation and Order of Confinement without prejudice. Based on notification that King County's enforcement has been terminated in this matter, the appeal is moot.

The appeal is accordingly DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE, the examiner's jurisdiction over the matter terminated, and the hearing scheduled for April 19, 2022, cancelled.

A dismissal without prejudice is not a finding on the merits, and it does not prevent an agency from later re-issuing a violation notice for the same underlying action. Any new notice would have its own appeal window.

If for some reason we have misunderstood the situation, by **May 4, 2022**, either party is free to file, with the examiner, a motion for reconsideration explaining why the examiner should not be dismissing this appeal. Filing a timely motion for reconsideration postpones the deadline (described below the signature line) for lodging an appeal.
