King County For-Hire Licensing has notified us that the inspector's report referenced the wrong number. Licensing has WITHDRAWN the Notice and Order of Violation dated December 11, 2019. Licensing intends to re-issue a corrected copy to Mr. Tura via US Mail.

We thus dismiss Licensing's order WITHOUT PREJUDICE. A dismissal without prejudice does not preclude Licensing from reissuing a violation notice regarding the same underlying event. Any new violation notice would have its own separate appeal deadline and examiner process. Given that Mr. Tura's initial appeal appeared to be untimely, if he wants to again

appeal, he should carefully follow the deadline and make sure he gets any appeal into Licensing by the deadline stated in the new notice.

Accordingly we CANCEL the hearing on Licensing’s motion to dismiss, scheduled for March 4.

If for some reason we have misunderstood the situation, by **March 26, 2020**, either party is free to file, with the examiner, a motion for reconsideration explaining why the examiner should not be dismissing this appeal. Filing a timely motion for reconsideration postpones the deadline (described below the signature line) for lodging an appeal.
