On March 14, 2024, King County For-Hire Licensing issued a notice and order. As that document stated, any appeal had to be received by King County For-Hire Licensing by April 8, 2024, or else the notice and order would become a final determination. That was consistent with KCC 20.22.080.B, which requires appeals to be received within 24 days of the date the agency determination is issued. The record reflects that the agency mailed the notice and order, by certified mail, to the address on record for Mr. Mohammedain.

<sup>1</sup> On October 1, Sgt. Taylor emailed us that our first Order of Dismissal had the incorrect notice and order issuance date. This has been corrected in this version from March 14, 2024, to March 14, 2025. All else remains the same.

King County For-Hire Licensing received Bassam Mohammedain’s appeal on September 2, 2025, almost six-months after the agency’s determination. Mr. Mohammedain’s appeal was submitted from the same address used to serve the original notice and order. King County For-Hire Licensing filed a motion to dismiss the appeal as untimely.

Under KCC 20.22.090, the examiner “shall” dismiss an untimely appeal. If the appeal is not received by the agency within 24 days of its determination, the examiner “does not have jurisdiction to consider the appeal and the decision of the department ... becomes final and unreviewable.” KCC 20.22.090.B.

The appeal is accordingly DISMISSED.

If we have misunderstood the situation, by **November 3, 2025**, either party may email us a motion for reconsideration explaining why we should not be dismissing this appeal. A timely motion postpones the deadline (described below the signature line) for seeking judicial review.
