

- Completed the draft MIMP document for legal review, with expected submission in early April rather than March.
- Started review of draft SEPA Checklist, and updated draft EIS amendment.
- (1) Received the Owner-Controlled Insurance Policy (OCIP) Feasibility Report. (2) Defined the RFQ foundational documents. (3) Attended four community events to promote the Bond Program RFQ.
