WHEREAS, the City of Enumclaw was incorporated a hundred years ago on January 27th 1913; and

WHEREAS, in the years since its incorporation, Enumclaw's residents, civic leaders, and businesses have partnered to maintain a strong sense of community and enhance the quality of life for its residents; and

WHEREAS, the commitment of its dedicated residents has made this city thrive; and

NOW, THEREFORE, we, King County Executive Dow Constantine and King County Councilmember Reagan Dunn, proclaim January 27th, 2013, as

ENUMCLAW DAY

in King County on the centennial anniversary of the city's incorporation.
